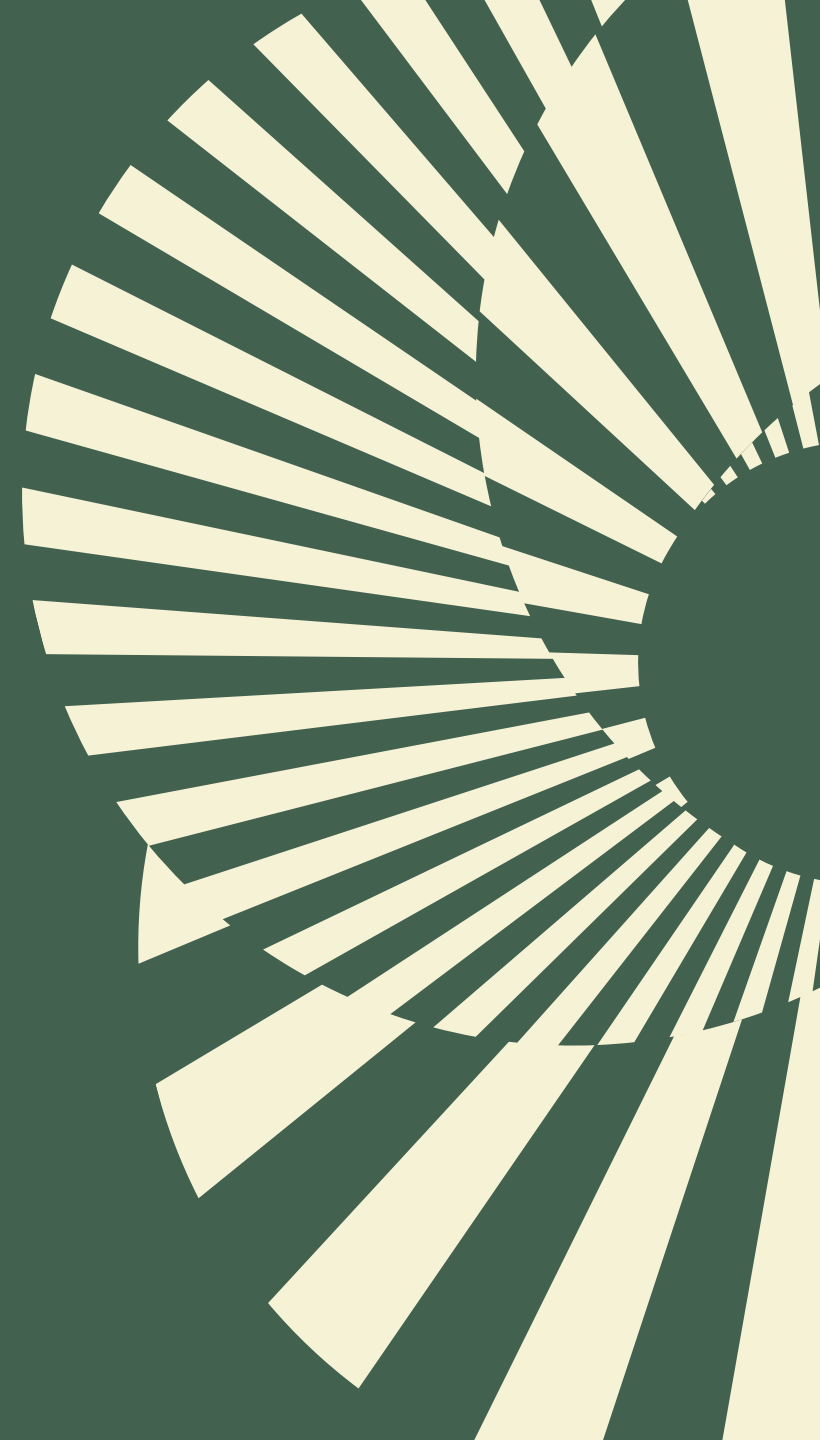

We leverage our network to respond quickly to time-bound emergencies, such as natural disasters, pandemics, and global threats.

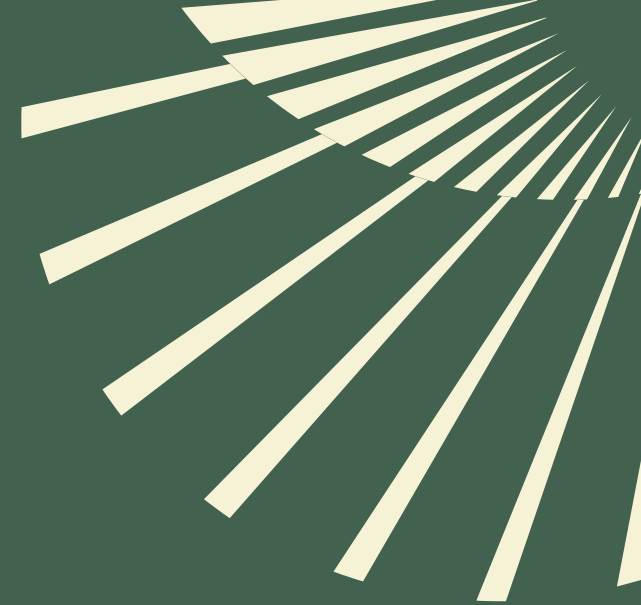

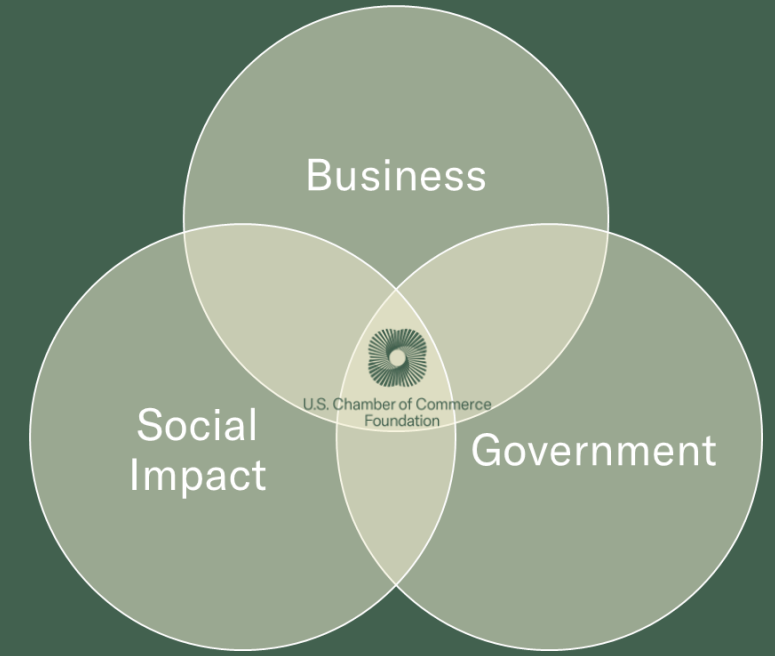

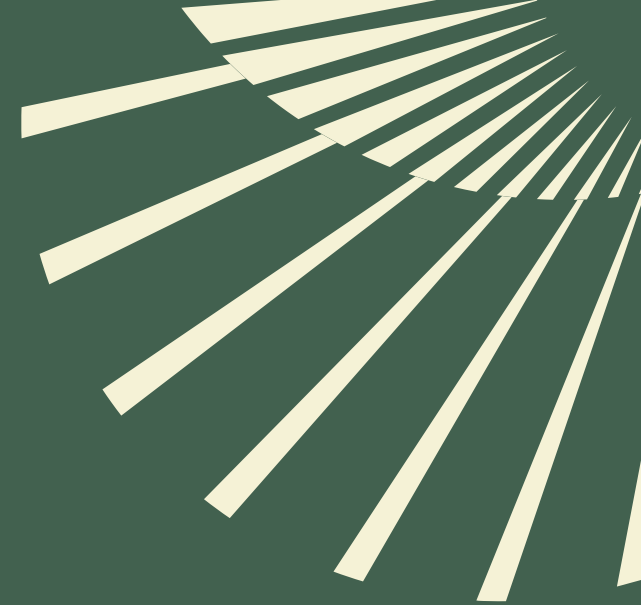
