




## The virus will mutate, but we don't know how




## The virus will mutate, but we don't know how

## Strengthen our tools. And use them wisely.

- 1. Increase vaccine uptake
  - U.S. is ranked 64<sup>th</sup> in the world
- 2. Wear masks...when needed
  - Reduce transmission by 56%
- 3. Invest in better filtration systems
  - HEPA filters reduce transmission by 65%
- 4. Scale up antigen testing
- 5. Increase supply of therapeutics
- 6. Strengthen surveillance
- 7. Communicate

- There will be an end... it's just not how you pictured it.
- Journey to an end is dependent on the virus, populationlevel policies, and individual-level decisions
